#### Description

The Domestic Response Capability (DRC) Kit consists of sense, protection, medical and decontamination equipment and provides an increased Non-Traditional Agent (NTA) capability for Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) Civil Support Teams (CSTs). The DRC Kit is a modularized configuration of the Advanced Threat (AT) Box equipment set consisting of same or upgraded components for transport inside CST vehicles. The DRC is an urgent need program.

This urgent need fielding solution will provide detection, personal protection, decontamination and medical monitoring against non-traditional agents.
