IFS

Description

The Integrated Footwear System (IFS) is a Chemical-Biological (CB) protective sock/liner system that is worn under normal combat footwear. The IFS is made from selectively permeable membrane materials and incorporates a Nomex elastic cuff. The IFS is issued as a component to the Joint Service Lightweight Suit Technology (JSLIST) and Joint Protective Aircrew Ensemble (JPACE) to meet Aviation and USSOCOM-specific CB footwear protection requirements.



Mission

To provide CB protection to the foot. IFS meets U.S. Navy (aviation), U.S. Marine Corps (aviation) and USSOCOM requirements.

- Provides 16 hours of CB footwear protection
