



Individual Equipment Decontamination Lit M295

M295 IEDK

Description

The M295 is a hand-held kit used to apply decontaminant to the individual's personal equipment. Each kit consists of a carrying pouch which contains four (4) sealed, soft-pack packets (enough to do two (2) complete individual equipment decontamination operations). Each packet contains 22 grams of powder for decontamination and utilizes the same powder as the M100 SDS System. The packet is designed to fit comfortably within a pocket of the battle dress over garment. Each individual wipe-down mitt in the kit is comprised of a decontaminating powder contained within a pad material and a polyethylene film backing. In use, powder from the mitt is allowed to flow freely through the pad material. Decontamination is accomplished through sorption of contamination by both the pad and the decontaminating powder. The M295 is issued in boxes of 20 kits.



Mission

To support the Warfighter by providing a sustainment system to decontaminate current and emerging threats.

Capabilities

- Decontaminate chemical-biological protective mask/hood, gloves, footwear, weapon, helmet, and load bearing equipment
- Preclude agent transfer during MOPP Gear exchange and entry or exit procedures
- Reduce the amount of agent a soldier touches and minimize the agent penetration into surfaces of individual equipment
