AFS-IFS

Description

The Integrated Footwear System (IFS) is a Chemical-Biological (CB) protective sock/liner system that is worn under normal combat footwear. The IFS is made from selectively permeable membrane materials and incorporates a Nomex elastic cuff. The IFS is issued as a component to the Joint Service Lightweight Integrated Suit Technology (JSLIST) and Joint Protective Aircrew Ensemble (JPACE) to meet Aviation and USSOCOM specific CB footwear protection requirements.

To provide CB protection to the foot.
