Description

iP2 is an emergency response and information management system focused on the incident command post (ICP) to emergency operations center interface with "All-Hazards" capable functionality. iP2 provides an integration platform that facilitates interoperability and provides a common operating picture (COP) that enables situational awareness for on-scene response and off-scene support personnel during all phases of incident management activities. The primary operators of the system are Department of Defense (DoD) civilians to include installation emergency management personnel, decision makers and first responders.

Mission

Integrate commercial off-the-shelf (COTS)/government off-the-shelf (GOTS) information technology solutions, fusing policies and technologies to deliver an improved capability to DoD installations and facilities for near real-time information sharing and dissemination in support of incident management operations.
